BY-ELECTION NOTICE

Nominations are called from eligible members for the election of:

State President (1 vacancy)

Nominations will be accepted from Thursday 6 January 2022.

Nomination forms are to be completed in accordance with Rule 14.6 of the *Constitution Rules of The Returned & Services League of Australia WA Branch Incorporated* and must reach me no later than 12.00 noon on Thursday 20 January 2022. Should an election be necessary, voting will close at 10.00 am on Thursday 17 February 2022.

Note: Candidates may include with their nomination form a statement not exceeding 150 words in length. The statement must be confined to biographical information about the candidate and the candidate's policies or beliefs and is not to contain information that the Returning Officer considers to be false, misleading or defamatory. The statement may also include other contact details such as a telephone number or email address and a passport size photograph of the candidate's head or head and shoulders, taken not less than 6 months before the date of the nomination.
